CAMP DETAILS

- 1. What are the dates and location of the camp?
 - The camp will be held from May 14 (Wed) to 17 (Sat) 2025. It will take place in Malacca (Malaysia) with accommodations (4D/3N) at Hatten Hotel (https://www.hattenhotel.com)
- 2. Who is eligible to attend the camp?
 - This camp is designed for seniors aged 60 and above, who are believers of Jesus Christ and members or regular worshippers of Faith MC and the SLM gathering.
- 3. What is mode of transport for this camp?
 - We will travel via tour bus: Pickup and Dropoff point at Faith Methodist Church (400 Commonwealth Drive S149604)
- 4. Where will we gather before departure?
 - We will meet in the church sanctuary at Level 1.
- 5. What is the schedule for departure?
 - During registration, you have the option to take the tour bus transport (all are encouraged to do so) or find your own way (e.g. drive, etc.)
 - Tour Bus Transport option: Please meet in church based on the time you have selected at the time of registration
 - On Your Own option: Please arrive Hatten Hotel prior to the opening service in the evening of 14 May. Do note that check-in time is after 3pm

REGISTRATION

1. How can I register for the camp?

- You can register online here https://eventreg.faithmc.sg/
- The main registrant must have a valid email address and only acceptable payment method is PayNow

2. Are there any early bird or group discounts?

Yes, early bird discounts are available for registrations made by 28 Feb 2025.

3. What is the cancellation policy?

- Cancellations made before **13 Apr 2025** (**30 days prior to the camp)** will receive a full refund. No refunds will be available after that date.
- If you need to cancel **within** one (1) month of Camp, we recommend you find a replacement for yourself. Replacement of participants are permitted at no additional charge if you inform SLM Camp committee at **least (2) weeks** before the Camp.
- In the event of medical conditions or bereavement-related reasons, we endeavour to make a partial refund (up to 50%) if documents/certificates can be produced.

ACCOMMODATION & LOGISTICS

1. How is transportation arranged?

- During registration, you have the option to take the tour bus transport (all are encouraged to do so) or find your own way (e.g. drive, etc.)^
 - Tour Bus Transport option: Please meet in church based on the time you have selected at the time of registration
 - On Your Own option: Please arrive Hatten Hotel prior to the opening service in the evening of 14 May. Do note that check-in time is after 3pm

2. Can I book a single room?

 No single room bookings are not applicable. Please email contact details for room pairing assistance

3. Are extra beds available at Hatten Hotel for triple sharing room?

• Yes, Hatten Hotel can provide a maximum of 30 extra beds, but these are also on a first-come, first-served basis.

4. What types of activities will be offered?

 Activities include Bible study sessions, worship, group discussions, recreational, fellowship opportunities and outreach programme.

5. What should I bring to the camp?

• Participants should bring personal toiletries, comfortable clothing, a Bible, and any necessary medications.

6. What if my spouse/caregiver is less than 60 years old?

• If you are 60 and above as of 2025, you can bring a spouse who is a believer in Jesus Christ, under 60 years of age. However please note certain nationalities will require a visa to enter Malaysia which you will have handle on your own.

7. What about travel insurance coverage?

- Please purchase your own travel insurance since the fees do not cover travel insurance.
- Please ensure that your passport has at least 6 months' validity.

Note: ^For those who choose to drive, a special 24-hour parking rate of RM5 per vehicle which allows multiple entries per day is available at the hotel reception; to validate at hotel reception each time before exiting. Cost is borne by camper.

1. Is there a medical emergency SOP in place at the camp?

- Rest assured we have a medical doctor in our midst who will step in to help in the event of a medical emergency.
- Hotel will have standard first aid kit and officer on duty

2. What is the camp's policy on medications?
