As our financial year draws to a close this July, we pause to thank God for His steadfast guidance and generous provision. He has surrounded Faith Methodist Church with faithful hands and opened doors for us to advance His mission.

As Faith Methodist Church turns 60 next year, we're especially grateful for God's provision and favour upon several significant moments in the life of our church:

1. Christmas @ Faith

Last year, *Christmas@Faith* saw **8,415 guests over three days**. It was a time to celebrate not just the season, but the relationships we've been building throughout the year. More than an event, *Christmas@Faith* was a living expression of Christ's love — shining His light into every corner of our neighbourhood.

2. Missions 2025

Missions 2025: Your Witness marks a fresh chapter in our commitment to the Great Commission. We thank God for stirring hearts, opening doors, and planting vision as we prepare to mobilise every generation to be a witness for Christ — locally and beyond. As of the time of writing, we have commissioned 253 mission trippers across 10 mission trips.

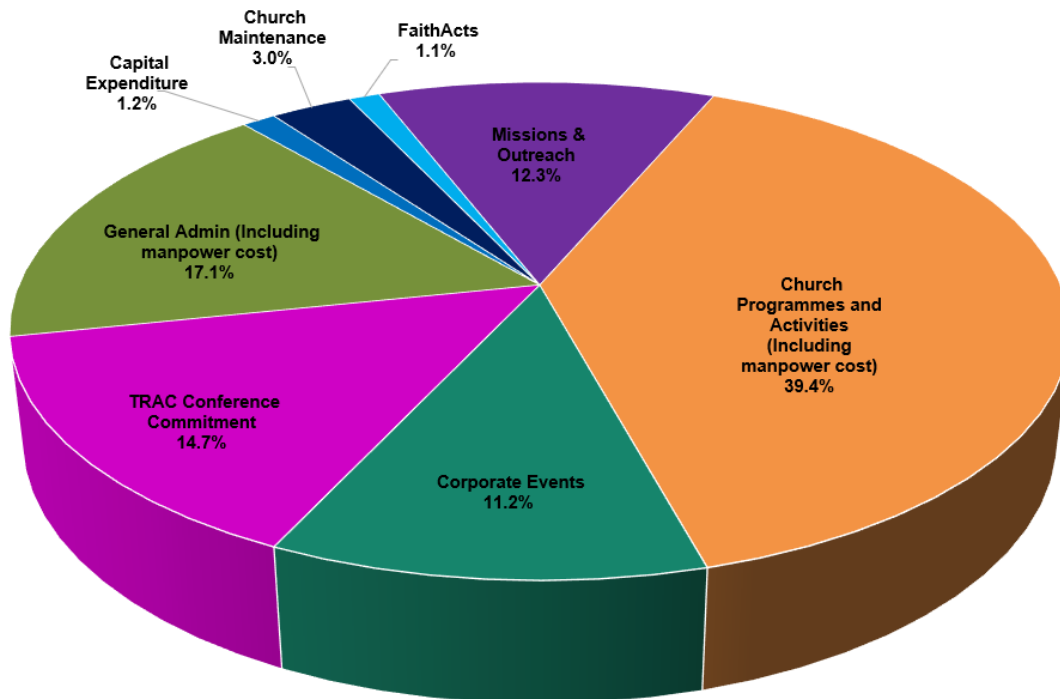
3. Church Camp 2026

Planning for our next Church Camp is well underway, and we thank God for paving the way — providing the right venue, partners, and people to help us shape a meaningful time of renewal, bonding, and spiritual growth for the Faith family.

In 2026, we aim to bring over 1,800 members of Faith Methodist Church — including 10% who are pre-believers — to Sunway Resort in Kuala Lumpur for a 4D3N camp. Our hope is to deepen our relationships with one another and with God through worship, witness, fellowship, and fun across all generations.

Budget Year August 2025 to July 2026

We would also like to share a summary of our budgeted full year expenditure of \$9.8m for next financial year.



Our main budget allocations are in Manpower costs, TRAC Conference Commitment, Missions and Outreach, Church Camp 2026.
